

Problem Structure


Concept: Subtraction

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to identify the problem structure and arithmetic operation and solve word problems involving subtraction.

TLM: Paper currency.

- Q. Augus went to market with ₹ 156. He spent ₹ 74.
How much money is now left with Augus?



Step-I :- I identify the problem structure. Here above the question falls under "Result Unknown" problem structure.



Step-II :- I identify the missing elements in the problem structure based on the key words of the problem.

Key words: Spent, left.

Step-3 :- Identify the operation to find the missing elements.



Augus spent some money. so total value is decreasing (less) a bit.

So we need to 'Subtraction'

Step-4 :- Apply the suitable operation to find out the missing elements

$$156 - 74 = 82$$

Result value is 82

Step-5 :- Re write the question in the form of a statement with all the values.

" Augus went to market with ₹ 156. He spent ₹ 74. Now ₹ 82 left with Augus."

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
